A scholarship to attend a Payroll Conference will be awarded to a deserving member each year at the regular August Chapter Meeting. This year the scholarship is for the 2016 Midwest Regional Payroll Conference. The scholarship will pay for the conference fee only. Travel and lodging are the responsibility of the scholarship recipient.

It is open to all active members of the Greater Kansas City Chapter of the American Payroll Association who are in good standing. To be eligible you must be available to attend the conference but not have funding from your current employer to pay for the conference. Those who are currently serving on the Board are not eligible for this scholarship award.

In order to be considered for the Conference Scholarship, please complete the following application and email it or have it post-marked no later than July 15, 2016, to our chapter email address at webmaster@apa-kc.org. The mailing address is PO Box 2051, Mission, KS 66201.

To qualify you must complete the application and you must provide proof that your employer will not pay for you to attend the conference. The proof must accompany your scholarship application.

The winner of the scholarship will be notified by phone or email as soon as the scholarship committee has made the selection. In addition, the winner will be announced and the scholarship awarded at the August Chapter Meeting. Registration information will follow.
